

ALL PURPOSE CLEANER

I found this recipe in the book *Gorgeously Green* several years ago, and it's still one of my favorites for use in the kitchen, and anywhere you don't need a gritty, hard stain remover. The tea tree oil is a natural antibacterial agent.

Ingredients

32 ounce spray bottle

2 cups water

½ cup distilled white vinegar

1 teaspoon pure castile soap (such as Dr Bronner's)- choose a scent you like

% cup hydrogen peroxide

20 drops tea tree oil

20 drops lavender, lemongrass, or other essential oil

Mix all ingredients together. I usually mix in a larger container (1 gallon vinegar plastic bottle that is empty). Then I dispense into various smaller containers to leave in kitchen, bathrooms, and around the house.

WINDOW AND GLASS CLEANER

Ingredients

2 cups water

¼ cup white vinegar

½ teaspoon liquid pure castile soap (such as Dr Bronner's)

Mix together into a spray bottle
